- Speak politely to adults and peers
- Respond when greeted
- Use polite responses at appropriate times. (Please, Thank you, You are welcome, Excuse me, yes, no)

I know I am respectful in the Classroom and in the School when I...

- Take turns to speak and respond
- Move about the building in a quiet and orderly manner in the morning, when changing classes, going to the cafeteria and during dismissal.
- Remember the sidewalks by the trailers are considered hallways.
- Walk to the right when in the halls
- Follow directions promptly
- Be punctual and prepared for all classes
- Greet visitors cordially
- Observe personal space
- Clean up after yourself
- Stop working and listen carefully to the morning Announcements on WELS
